In all cases in which state prisoners are transported to the United States Courthouse in Mobile, Alabama, or Selma, Alabama, pursuant to writs of habeas corpus ad testificandum, it is ORDERED that the United States Marshall accept delivery of those prisoners at the courthouse door and maintain custody and control of such prisoners at all times they are within the courthouses.
