STORMWATER TANKS TAKE UP POSITION ON SITE

ASK any Mobilian to tell you something about their city and they are likely to tell you that it rains a lot (66 inches per year avg.) Under Federal guidelines the project is required to manage stormwater runoff on site to the maximum extent technically feasible. One solution to this challenge is with stormwater tanks positioned in the perimeter landscaped areas. The tanks are assembled from individual modules measuring 3' x 1.5' x 2'-10" tall. In all there are 4 storage tanks, with gravel beds, that make up a combined volume of over 8,000 cubic feet or the equivalent of 60,000 gallons of water.

MAKING STEPS: In March work continued on many fronts, including the front entrance courthouse steps where concrete walls were poured and backfilled, and forming the steps began. Limestone installation was completed on the west elevation of the building this month. In the main lobby the floor was prepped and terrazzo installation began and construction of the security desk began.

CAMPBELL DESIGN: The team held their week long integrated design review meetings on the 90% construction documents in March and is now working to develop the 100% construction documents.
