The U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Alabama, located at 155 Saint Joseph Street, Mobile, Alabama, is requesting quotes for forty-one (41) LG 40WT95UF-W monitors or equivalent that matches the below specifications. Selection will be made based on the lowest priced, technically acceptable offer.

The following specifications are requirements for the requested 40-inch ultrawide monitor to be considered technically acceptable:

- Monitor size: 40 inches. Resolution: 5Kx2K.
- Thunderbolt 5 PC charging and video transmission port.
- Built-in network card.
- Built-in USB-C hub with at least two (2) USB-A ports, two (2) Thunderbolt ports, and five (5) USB-C ports.
- A headphone audio jack.
- At least one (1) HDMI port.
- Mac compatibility.

- A Thunderbolt 5 cable included.
- Power supplied by standard IEC C13 power cable with no external power supply.
- Most plugs positioned perpendicular to the back of the monitor and not parallel with the back of the monitor so that gravity will not work plugs loose over time.
- A supplied sturdy, fully adjustable stand with a cable management passthrough that can be easily removed and replaced with a VESA-compatible stand if needed.

Preferred specs which are not required include: Built-in webcam.

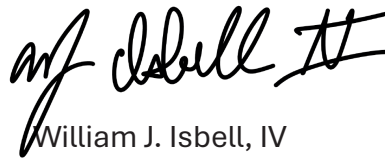
