**STANDING ORDER NO. 32**

Courts has ordered that probation officers give notice to the State Attorney General's Office, local police departments and sheriff's offices of the location of offenders in their communities if convicted of drug trafficking or crimes of violence to include sex offenders.

The Court grants permission for the probation office in the Southern District of Alabama to disclose the entire criminal history section of the presentence report to law enforcement agencies, with the exception of juvenile adjudications (Part B).
