The Guide to Judiciary Policy, Volume 13: Finance and Budget, Chapter 8: Criminal Debt, Section 825.15.15 provides guidance for this Court on establishing an account before issuance or docketing of a judgment in a criminal case. In accordance with Section 825.15.15(a) governing payments before sentencing, and to memorialize the Court's existing procedure for handling same, it is hereby **ORDERED** that the clerk's office may receive criminal debt funds before the court's judgment is issued or docketed when a defendant, after a plea is entered but before sentencing, makes a payment towards an anticipated special assessment, restitution, or fine.
