**PERMANENT POWER ON:** At the beginning of July, Alabama Power (APC) delivered and set the two network transformers and by the middle of the month the power was on. The switch from temporary power to permanent power is an important milestone for the project and enabled the contractor to start up the mechanical chillers to begin producing conditioned air in the building.
