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MAKING A BREAKTHROUGH

QUEUING up for screening when entering the Campbell building has long been an inconvenience to the public with lines literally out the door due to space constraints in the existing main entrance vestibule. This month, the contractor took steps to creating a new screening area with improved throughput to the north of the vestibule by opening up a passageway through the original vestibule wall.

OTHER PROGRESS: Roofing work continued on the highest roof levels and the main roof. Carpet and LVT began on level 5. Ceiling tile and lighting wrapped up on level 4. Electrical trim out and door casings went in on level 3. Toilet fixtures and ceiling grid were set on level 2. Drywall and OH rough-in continued on level 1. Demolition and preparing for new concrete occurred inside the loading dock.

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
