



In order for probation officers to comply with the Federal Sex Offender Registration and Notification Act and related State and Federal regulations regarding notification of certain sex offenders, officers may be required, on an as needed basis, to disclose certain confidential information. The Court authorizes disclosure of the required confidential information on sex offenders according to State and Federal regulations.

(11) You shall permit a probation officer to visit at any time at home or elsewhere and shall **permit** confiscation of any contraband observed in plain view by the probation officer.

(12) You shall notify the probation officer within seventy-two hours of being arrested or questioned by a law enforcement officer.

(13) You shall not enter into any agreement to act as an informer or a special agent of a law enforcement agency without the permission of the court.

(14) As **directed** by the Probation **Officer**, you shall **notify** third parties of risks that may be occasioned by your criminal record or personal **history** or **characteristics**, and shall permit the probation officer to make such notification and to confirm your compliance with such notification requirement.

(15) You shall not have any type of firearm in your possession, custody, or control.

(16) You shall refrain from conduct or activities which would give reasonable cause to believe you have violated any **criminal law**.

(17) You shall pay any fine or restitution imposed by a judgment that remains unpaid at the commencement of the term **of supervision in accordance** with any Schedule of Payments set forth in the Criminal Monetary Penalties sheet **of the** judgment. In any case, you shall cooperate with the probation officer in meeting any financial obligation.

For offenses committed on or after September 13, 1994:

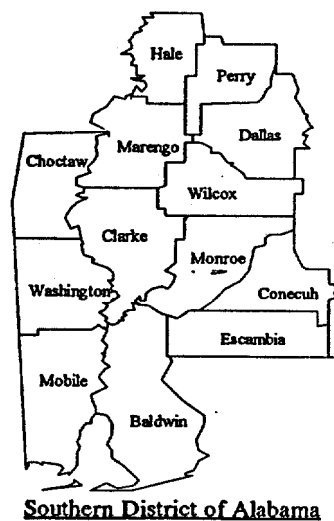
(18) You shall refrain from any unlawful use of a **controlled substance**. You shall submit to one drug test within 15 days of release **from** imprisonment or placement on probation and at least two periodic drug tests thereafter, as directed by the probation **officer**.

The above drug testing condition is suspended based on the court's determination that the offender poses a low risk of future substance abuse. (Check if applicable).

Upon a finding of a violation of probation or **supervised** release, I understand **that** the Court may (1) revoke supervision or (2) extend the term of supervision and/or modify the conditions of supervision.

These conditions have been **read** to me. I fully understand **the** conditions, and have been provided a copy of them.

Within three (3) days after your release, you are to report to the U. S. Probation Office.
